





Conservation work on St James' continues at a pace as the replacement of our 60+ year old wiring reaches



its final stage together with the installation of an all new lighting system. If you have not seen the difference it makes then do go and see.

However as the picture below shows it also serves to highlight the extent of the conservation tasks ahead!



We have now gratefully received the first £10,000 of the £20,000 granted by Stratford Town Trust towards our

electrical works and this first stage of the conservation work should all be completed by the time you read this! What progress...! WARNING!

All visitors to St James' need to be aware of the possibility of falling masonry. See right a piece that fell off during the recent heavy rains. For safety scaffolding will be erected around the base of the tower.



Following the setting up of the Friends of St James' (FOSJ) regular monthly meetings have been arranged. At the first meeting it was discussed and agreed that the FOSJ should be run as a separately registered charity. This process has now been started along the lines of the very successful Friends of the Old Church, Alveston. The aims of the FOSJ will also be very similar and reflect the conservation work required as well as the long term maintenance requirements to the fabric of the building.

A suggestion that membership of the FOSJ should be open to everyone who wishes to be connected with the project was warmly welcomed. A £10 subscription per year was discussed and received a favourable reaction. This would ensure those who wished to join as a **friend** would be kept informed of our progress.

Paul Daniels on Saturday 3 October is an excellent start to our programme of fundraising events being drawn up by the FOSJ committee.

We are also delighted to confirm that the University of Warwick Chamber Choir will be holding their forth Concert in St James' at 6.30pm Sunday 8 November entitled 'Polyphony through the Ages' all profits from the Concert will go to the FOSJ appeal.



Our curate the Rev'd Mary Kent was duly ordained as a Priest on Saturday 4th July in a packed Coventry Cathedral by the Bishop of Coventry the Rt. Rev'd Christopher Cocksworth. Mary will continue to work in the parish for another 2 years and we look forward to

her growing contribution now that she is a Priest.

On Sunday 2nd August late in the evening a "quite large cherry tree" on the corner of the churchyard (Church Lane and Kissing Tree Way) fell over blocking the road! A kindly neighbour informed the



police and the tree was quickly sawn up and cleared out of the road by the highways agencies of Warwickshire County Council. Fortunately no one was hurt and no property came to any harm. Even the Church

wall escaped damage! Closer inspection revealed how, as the majority of the tree ended up in the roadway on the other side of the wall. Well the Cherry Tree was rotten inside! It had "snapped off" some distance above the ground clearing the wall when it fell

avoiding costly repairs to the church wall.


