## **STOP PRESS – CORE STRATEGY APPROVED!**

A Special meeting of Stratford District Council on Monday voted to submit its final version of the Core Strategy, including the building of 10,800 new houses between 2011 and 2031, to the Planning Inspectorate. The strategy includes 2,500 homes at the new town at Gaydon and Lighthorne Heath. **40 Councillors voted in favour of the strategy, two against and two abstaining.**

## 1<sup>st</sup> Anniversary

As the expression goes 'how time flies'! We have now been fighting the Gallagher planning application to build 270 houses on land at Arden Heath Farm for a year. Gallagher had their initial consultation meeting with residents in Tiddington on 29<sup>th</sup> August 2013. Our first Residents' CAUSE meeting at the Lazy Cow was on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2013.

With everyone's help we have achieved a lot since then. Some important wins have been

- Getting over 300 letters of objection in to the Council Planning Officer – the volume of response surprised them and they realised this was a big issue to you all.
- Speaking at and getting the support for our objections from the Stratford Town Council
- Getting enough support to defeat the option to build 2500 houses as part of the core strategy between Banbury Road and Tiddington
- Raising enough legitimate planning issues to have the Planning Committee postponed
- Raising enough money to use 2 expert consultants to help put together our case for objection

## Planning Committee

Because of issues we have raised regarding traffic lights at Clopton Bridge the meeting planned for the 10<sup>th</sup> September has been postponed until Highways produce a revised report. We will let you know when we have a new date. It will be absolutely essential that we get a good attendance of residents at that. We had a large turnout for the residents meeting at the football ground – we will need that kind of response again.

We still need anecdotes from you to support our objections at the Planning Committee. These bring alive for members of the Planning Committee what the issues are for all of you. In particular we would like to hear about:

- Difficulties anybody has had getting their children into schools.
- Any horror stories you have regarding traffic congestion on local roads
- The dangers of cycling locally

## PR Campaign

Just prior to the Planning Committee we want to raise our PR profile in the papers, radio and TV. We plan to arrange a good natured (but with a serious message) event that highlights the problem with the proposed traffic lights on Clopton Bridge. Again we will need your support for this. There is no point in doing this if only a few people participate. Nobody we have spoken to is happy about the plan to put traffic lights on the junction of the bridge with Tiddington Road – this will be your chance to make your point.

## NO Posters

These have worked well in raising the profile of the CAUSE campaign so a big thanks to those of you who have them in your window. We want to freshen them up ready for when the Planning Committee come on a site visit (date still not known). So we plan to do a new version and mail drop a poster to houses on Loxley Road, Burford Road and Wootton Close – the likely roads to be used by the committee on their visit. Please put the poster up when you get it. It won't be for long and it will make a difference.
