

And of course you can then join Derek on a Tuesday to New Equipment We have now installed and have performed simple test to ensure it is all working on the following: An *Induction Loop* system for the hard of hearing. (Tune hearing aids to T). All new theatre grade tracking and plumb velour fire resistant drapes for the stage together with dim out legs and a pair of rear dim out drapes. All very professional! In addition we have a 3.5 meter electrically operated projection screen. Also on stage we have a lighting bar with lanterns and floods etc. Front of stage we have another lighting bar in the hall roof with 6 lanterns and a superb quality daylight projector attached. Securely housed we have CD and DVD players, with 4 fullrange speakers, radio microphones and power amplifiers, plus a Juggler and Chilli to control the stage lights! Anyone who understands the lighting system should make an emergency call to Rob ASAP so they can help us to set this up! We will need to find a simple way of ensuring that users of the TCC can be given "fool-proof" instructions on operating this expensive equipment. Plus an easy charging structure. We are also looking earnestly on the licensing implications which we need to sort out ASAP!
