Our last 4 fund raising events (golf, big band concert, a play & wine tasting) raised almost £4,000 making a total so far of over £20,000 in one year! Two major sources of funds at £50K & £8K have been grants from the

**Alveston PCC & Stratford Town Trust** for which we are very grateful. The financial support received from many individuals and businesses in our community has also been generous - making the total raised to date of over £80,000. However having completed an architectural survey of the works needed to conserve St James' a grant application has now been submitted to English Heritage. This covers **just one phase** of our multi-phased project with repairs to the tower and nave roof now estimated at £250,000! 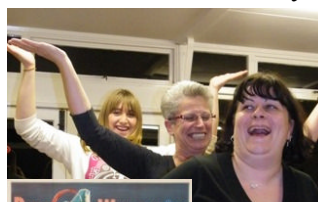

# NEWS FROM THE PARISH OF ALVESTON

St James' with St Peter's Manor Road

## Emmanuel – “God with US”

If you talk about “Carols” people immediately think of Christmas Carols, but in fact Carols can be written for any occasion or season of the year. Many Churches today have an Advent Carol Service to mark the beginning of the season leading up to Christmas, and sometimes people are disappointed when some of their favourite Christmas Carols are not sung at such a service.

That rather misses the point! Advent Carols are specifically to prepare us for the festive season to come and are different in content to the Christmas ones, although there is some cross over.

One favourite amongst Advent Carols, which can also be sung at Christmas, is “O come, O come, Emmanuel”. This is a Carol based on the great “O Antiphons”, special verses sung before the ‘Magnificat’ at Evening Prayer on the seven days up to Christmas Eve. These are very ancient, possibly in use as early as the 6<sup>th</sup> Century. Each one speaks of one of the biblical titles of Jesus, *O Sapientia (Wisdom)*, *O Adonai, leader of the people of Israel*, *O Radix Jesse (Root of Jesse)*, *O Clavis David (Key of David)*, and so on. As each one is used, almost like a liturgical Advent calendar, we draw closer to Christmas until, on the eve of the great day we sing *O Emmanuel, God with US*. Christmas brings our God into our homes, our hearts, and the ordinary day to day of our lives, because God chose to save us by becoming one of us. He left his divinity and took upon himself our humanity that we too might be divine.

On **SUNDAY 28<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER, 18.30hrs** at St James' there will be an **ADVENT CAROL SERVICE** during which we reflect upon those great ‘O Antiphons’ and pray again for God to be with us this Christmas time and at all times, as we celebrate the birth of Jesus, our own Emmanuel.
