# **Planning Committee - Alert**

# **Dear Resident**

# **URGENT Warning:**

# Our community may never be the same again after 18<sup>th</sup> December 2014.

Are you prepared for the devastation if Stratford Planning Committee vote through the **270 new houses on Loxley Road?** 

You have the opportunity to stop this development. But before I explain how, I want to remind you why this matters.

#### And this letter will take 2 minutes to read. It is critical.

So let me briefly explain...

If this huge housing development goes ahead there will be an increase of 500+ cars on our local roads in peak times every day, mostly on Loxley Road.

The congestion will be terrible. And these cars will increase the chances of **serious accidents** for all, *including our children*. There will also be an increase in carbon monoxide with unknown led pollution and possible health side effects.

#### And not only that...

...with a doubling of the number of houses on Loxley Road the community will never be the same again. The familiarity of residents will give way to a community that is too large to be familiar. Pedestrians will be unknown and crime may well increase.

But there is more, please bear with me, before I share how we can stop this...

Wildlife habitats will be decimated.

**New traffic lights** will be placed at the end of Tiddington Road and on Clopton Bridge to cope with these houses. This will increase your journey times across the bridge.

And for families it gets worse. There will be pressure on school places. Our local parents will face the difficulty of having to place children of a similar age at different schools, with longer travelling times.

But the noise and pollution from these cars will be nothing compared to...

...the disturbance during **3 years of construction work**..., with earth moving equipment, lorries, mud on the roads, drilling, cement mixers and other disturbances.

I'm sorry to share the above.

But this will all happen and more. UNLESS...

...you, me and all of our neighbours and community spend 2 hours of our time attending one meeting. That's all we need to do, to stop the above.

Let's stop the profiteering developers who care nothing for our community. They are taking advantage of the Core Strategy timing loophole to force through this development. This development is simply not necessary here.

Quite simply...this is the <u>FINAL DECISION</u> on whether to allow 270 houses to be built on Loxley Road (using land on Arden Heath Farm).

With you, we have a chance of stopping this development. Without you and every one of our community we have no chance.

#### It is that simple.

We have been advised, by other successful objectors, that unless residents show opposition, a full community turn out, attending the committee, <u>we have little chance of winning.</u>

So, it is up to YOU...

...attend and stop the development, or stay at home and miss your moment in history to make a difference, for our community. A moment that will make a difference for generations to come.

## But what exactly should you do to attend?

Firstly, please get a pen!

Then add the following date and time of the meeting to your diary:

- 5pm on Thursday 18th December.
- Address of meeting: District Council Offices, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford. (Members of the CAUSE committee, plus local Ward Councilors' will be speaking against the development.)

...and you are right 5pm on a Thursday is not the best time! But the developers will be happy with this timing, so let's make sure they do not take advantage of this.

Attending the meeting <u>will be enough of a contribution from you</u>, no questions or speech will be needed!

It is simply *our numbers together that will make THE DIFFERENCE.* Every single person counts. You being there is critical.\_

And one more thing...

Just so we know numbers who will be attending <u>please reply to this</u> email, if not already done so, with the words: "Yes, I will be there."

The Club's purpose is to provide social interaction for people with visual impairment and to keep members up to date with 'what is going on' for those with poor sight.

We have over 35 members with an age ranging from 60 to 104 years. Some members are in sheltered accommodation whilst the majority live independently in their own homes.

The Club meets at St Andrew's Church Centre, Shottery every two weeks on a Thursday from 2-4pm when afternoon teas (sandwiches and cakes) are served. We have either a speaker or entertainment at each meeting. We also have four lunch outings per year. Transport can be provided.

For the majority of our members the 'As you like it' club is a lifeline. Members gain tremendous support from each other. And are able to share their problems and in many cases a fellow member is able to offer 'a good solution'.

TYPHOON HAIYAN remembered

It is almost a year since the most powerful storm ever recorded hit the island communities of the Philippines. Thanks to the support of our donors, ShelterBox launched one of its largest responses to date and is still today committed to assisting families that were affected by the storm.

Throughout this past week, ShelterBox has reflected upon Typhoon Haiyan as we remember the communities in the Philippines that suffered at the violence of the storm and the communities around the world that rallied together in their support.

## 'Thank you' from Chip Chip

In the village of Machumben, lived one of the estimated five million children who were affected by Typhoon Haiyan. His name was Chip Chip.

At the time of writing, Chip Chip was five years old and was one of 18 in his family. His mum was also seven months pregnant when the storm hit their home.

Thanks to ShelterBox donors, Chip Chip and his family received a ShelterBox tent and other aid items allowing them to continue farming their land and beginning to rebuild their destroyed home.

# Continued commitment in the Philippines

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, we have maintained our commitment to the Philippines and are extending the type of help we are able to offer these communities, several months after the Typhoon first struck.

After a careful assessment process, ShelterBox entered into four project partnerships with leading international agencies including ACTED (Agency for Technical Cooperation and Development), Handicap International, Catholic Relief Services (CRS) and Islamic Relief Worldwide (IRW) which will lead to the construction of nearly 1,700 'core transitional' shelters.
