Winter's weather causes additional problem at St James' Church!

Additional safety fencing has been erected to the area surrounding the base of the Church Tower at St James' and warning notices have been posted! We believe that this will add significant protection for all who visit St James' and the Churchyard as we are continuing to experience large pieces of masonry falling from the tower. We recommend that when entering and leaving St James' Church itself that you move quickly away from the tower area. Visitors to the Churchyard are advised that they should enter through the North side gate and not through the main entrance on Church Lane.

We are now in the process of setting Phase 2 of the repairs in place and to this aim we have appointed a new Church Architect, Mark Evans. Mark is currently preparing a report and quotes for conservation work to the tower and roof. If at all possible we would like to start work in June so work can be completed before the first autumn frosts! Phase 2 now looks like costing at least £300,000. This means the revised estimate for the total now required is well over £500,000. We do not have anything like this amount and so we will need to raise a significant amount of money and quickly!

With this in mind, any offers of help with fundraising ideas and donations both small and large, even very large, are extremely welcome! We have, as you will already be aware, setup a registered charity the Friends of St James' (FoSJ) who have raised over £30,000 in the last 12 months under the Chair of Richard Hyde.

Fundraising Going Strong

The Friends of St James' had a busy 2010 and the Committee will report to its members at the AGM

at 7.30pm on the 29th March at St James'. Whilst the big news was the failure to secure English Heritage funding the Friends have still made excellent progress towards raising enough money to start the preservation work on St James'. During 2010 the FoSJ held eight fund raising events ranging from A Summer's Evening of readings and music, raffles at the Humpty Dumpty pantomime, Passion Play, a Golf Day, a Big Band Concert plus a wine tasting - almost one event every month!

During the year we received a grant of £5,000 from the Stratford Town Trust and on top of this we have received donations of a further c£9,000. It is now hoped that quotes for Phase 1, conserving the Tower as well as urgent repair work to the main roof, can be submitted for approval in March or April and that work could even start as early as June! Quite a challenging time frame!


Lenten loy!

Easter is late this year, as late as it can be. This is because Easter Day is the Sunday after the first full moon after the Spring Equinox and this year we have a full moon on 19th March just a day before the Equinox on 20th. (The equinox is when we have equal hours of dark & light in a day).

The next full moon after that is a full lunar month away on 18th April, a Monday, so the following Sunday, 24th is Easter Day! This means that Lent starts late too, not beginning until Ash Wednesday, 9th March. Soon after the clocks will

go forward and the lengthening spring days will be with us.

Chance to get outside after the long winter nights to tidy up the garden, go for a stroll, or do some more serious exercise, jogging perhaps (not the vicar!). Perhaps this late Lent is a real opportunity to take up something new rather than give something up and try to get physically as well as spiritually fit.
