GREAT NEWS! Together we have raised enough money to purchase a **Rapid Response Vehicle (RRV)** for our two local CFR Volunteers to use when on call.

Yes, thanks to all the money that you generously donated, we have purchased the car shown below and paid for the insurance and signage! In fact, we have committed to the **Avon Valley Community First Responders (AVCFRS)**, that we will pay the running costs of the RRV for two years!

The RRV was first used by our Volunteer CFRs **Julia** and **Karen** on Saturday 22 June when they were soon out responding to three 999 Emergencies that very first day. The RRV is run by the Avon Valley Scheme and is available for use by their other CFRs.

Our Urgent need is for more Volunteer CFRs! Both our local CFRs work full-time and so they are giving up their "free" time at weekends and in the evenings. And so we really need additional CFRs to cover our area and who would be available during the day! And this is just for our local area!

We may just have found the first of these volunteers! And an application to become a CFR is now underway for **Sheena**! There is of course a lot of training to go through yet and it will be some months before her process is completed. We wish **Sheena** every success and thank her most sincerely for volunteering to train as a local CFR.

The Friends of St James' (FoSJ) Church

need to "find" another £130K to fund the current conservation work! Over the past four years £381,000 has been raised and spent on Phases 1 and 2. **Phase3** will cost another £200,000. We have £70,000 leaving just £130,000 more to find...

Can you help? You will have noticed the work to-date on the tower has significantly increased its visibility! If you have ventured inside St James' you will have seen the vast changes to the interior lighting. If you made one of those "Trips to the Top" you had a great opportunity to inspect the Tower masonry work close-up.

In Phase3 the exterior work continues, rebuilding part of the South Porch and ensuring the fabric is waterproof at the South East corner. Major problems with falling plaster on the inside south wall and windows also require urgent attention - **as soon as we have more money!**



A church in Alveston has stood at the heart of the community south of the river for the best part of a thousand years. St James', an interesting example of Victorian architecture, replaced the older, Saxon church shown. Our active Congregation grew in 2012 by 10%, includes all ages and boasts two choirs, the adults ranging from 16 to 70+ years, a junior choir of some 20 youngsters aged 6 to 15+. We run a Youth Group at the TCC; have a thriving band of Bell-ringers and a 2nd congregation at St Peter's, Manor Road. Congregation members support many local charities including the TCC, the food bank, our local CFRs, the Blind Club etc.

Significant grants from the Town Trust, many personal gifts plus FoSJ fundraising events have funded our conservation with shortfalls being met from our Church reserves.

All churches depend on the generosity of well-wishers near and far for their survival. Could you play a part in helping ensure our Church buildings can serve the community of the future?

Tiddington Community Centre

At the **Annual General Meeting (AGM)** of the **Tiddington Community Centre** it was reported that TCC income for the year to 31 march 2013 amounted to £20,785 (£20,707 in 2011/12) and that in spite of spending £11,517 (£2,480 in 2011/12) on improvements and by keeping running costs well under control a small surplus of £512 was made. The TCC Net Assets now stands at £34,837 (not including restricted funds of £6,043 held on behalf of our Community First Responder activities and £138 for the BlueFish Youth Group). **Chair Rob Coble**y thanked all members of the Executive Committee for their continued support throughout the year, making a special presentation to **Erica Johnston**, who was standing down after serving 5 years as Chair followed by a further 8 years as Secretary! The TCC is delighted to report that **Stewart Band** has taken on the role of Secretary and we are pleased to confirm that **John Fox** remains as our much valued Treasurer. Other members of the Exec are **Jo Connolly, Eric Davies, Janice Howkins, Gareth Millard, Jenny Tinsley and Richard Williams**. This means we have one vacancy on our Executive Committee and so if you are interested in applying for this position please contact Chair Rob Coble. We passed one significant milestone during the year when the income from lettings, received since the fire at the TCC in 2007, and the re-opening on 11 September 2008 exceeded £100,000.

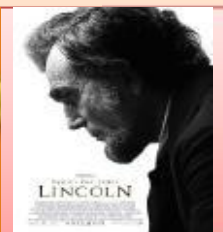

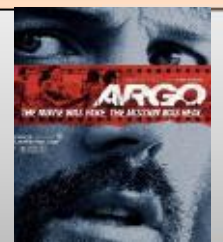
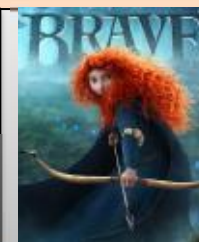

NEWS IN THE PARISH OF ALVESTON

What IS the Church FOR?

A seemingly simple question, most people would assume we mean the Church BUILDING, so the simple answer would be it is there for people to meet in who want to worship God, and for our weddings, baptisms and funerals.

The real answer, however, is very different and dependent on understanding what the word 'CHURCH' really means. 'Church' is not the building but the people in it, the members of the body of Christ who meet together to worship God and to gain strength for the week ahead to BE Christ's body in the world.

To that purpose the Church is, like former Archbishop, William Temple, once said "the only institution which exists solely for those who are not part of it".

Our aim, as the Body of Christ, is to serve the needs of the people around us, to serve each other, as Christ came to serve us, as we so popularly sing these days in the Graham Kendrick hymn 'The Servant King'.

It isn't always easy to do that. One part of the Diocesan Mission Statement to which we subscribe is "To Transform Communities", meeting the needs of others in the community so that they can see Christ's love for his people in action. I remember a preacher once saying 'Christianity' should be a verb not a noun, a 'doing' word, not a 'name'.

In Alveston parish it isn't always easy to identify the needs. We are an affluent parish on the whole and the real needs are less visible than in poorer areas. We do, however, support the Stratford Food Bank and both of our Churches are collection points for food donations. We also run two 'Tea and Chat' sessions every week, one at the TCC on a Friday from 2.00pm and one at St. Peter's Manor Road from 2.00pm on a Monday. All are made welcome to those friendly gatherings. We have also been running a weekly youth group, 'Blue Fish', for the youngsters in the community and hope to re-launch that in September.

On top of that Church members individually are involved in helping with and supporting many other good works in the Community, Hospices, Blind Club, McMillan, Cancer Research, Oxfam and many more. It may just be that they are kind good-hearted people but as members of Christ's body in the community they share his love with those they serve.

On top of this we give away 10% of our income to charity and our biggest collection every year, at the Chistingle on Christmas Eve, goes to the Children's Society. If you have any other causes you think we could support then please let us know, and if you can offer us any help we would be pleased to see you.

HARVEST THANKSGIVING this year will be on Sunday 22nd September

We will be making a special collection of tinned and packet food for the Food Bank as well as raising money for 'US' a charity that works with some of the poorest in the developing world, and sharing that money with a charitable cause in the local community.
